1. CALL TO ORDER

3. CITY IN GENERAL
 - 3.1 Discussed and considered for approval amended bylaws for Pittsburg Economic Development Corporation.

Councilmember David Abernathy motioned to approve with the following changes in article II in the first paragraph, first sentence we need to strike thru (delete) where it says 5 member board. The sentence needs to read: The City Council of the City of Pittsburg shall appoint or remove by majority vote of a quorum of City Council Members.
